Producers

Plant, cultivate, grow, harvest and dry marijuana.



Processors

Process marijuana into cannabinoid products, concentrates or extracts.



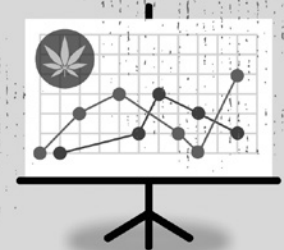
Wholesalers

Purchase marijuana from other licensed facilities and store, transport or sell the products to other licensees.



Retailers

Sell or deliver marijuana items directly to consumers.



Researchers

Research marijuana for the purpose of benefiting the state's cannabis industry, medical research, or public health and safety.



Labs

OLCC licensed and accredited by Oregon Environment Laboratory Accreditation Program (ORELAP).



Packaging and Labeling

All products sold according to the OHA and OLCC requirements.



Marijuana Worker Permit

Employees who perform work on behalf of an OLCC licensed producer, processor, wholesaler or retailer.
